

FEI Arrival Procedure for international horses, stabled national horses and horse personal

Tell the OC your estimated time of arrival.

On arrival, report to the vet responsible for the arrival examination.

Horses

Here you must present

1. your horse passport, the horse will then be identified.
2. valid FEI equine influenza vaccinations
3. with horses from abroad: official veterinarian attestation
4. horse rectal temperatures must be measured twice daily for 10 days before the rides i.e., as from 14th or 15th September depending on the day you arrive and recorded using the FEI Horse App or form for national horses
5. horses are not required to have EHV1 vaccinations. EHV1 vaccinations are advisable. The participants must state that they do not come from a stable or horse farm suffering from an infectious disease

Measure the horse's temperature yourself with your own thermometer in front of the examining vet, record the temperature.

If the horse's temperature is not more than 38,5 C, the horse may enter the stables

Participants

1. register yourself and your crew per Luca App or put your name on the list or in the secretary's office using the written form
2. check Covid 19 requirements and abide by the hygiene requirements for the state of Brandenburg (this may mean you have to confirm that you and your team members are vaccinated, recovered from a covid infection, or have negative Covid tests which are not older than 24 hrs.)

If the requirements have been met, then you may park your horsebox or trailer in the designated area or in the two separate fields, one for international horses and one for national horses. (See site plan)

Take your horse(s) to the stables and find your designated box. – A stable plan will be sent to you before you come and will be posted on the stables.

National riders that do not stable their horses and only require paddocks can drive directly to the national paddock and parking area.
